## **INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS**

### **PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!**

#### **Availability of Funds**

We are pleased to offer the opportunity for you to apply for financial aid for the 2008 Summer Terms. Students attending summer school will have their full, demonstrated need met for up to two Duke campus or Marine Lab summer terms or Duke-sponsored Summer Study Abroad programs. These two terms need not be consecutive. To apply for these funds, you will need to complete the appropriate summer school financial aid application form. The application for Duke-campus and Marine Lab summer terms is attached. **The Duke Summer Study Abroad Financial Aid Application is available through the Study Abroad Office.** *Please note that some summer programs, such as Duke in New York, are two-session programs, and will use both of a student's eligible summer terms for aid.*

Financial aid is awarded on a per-term basis. Summer Session I aid is based on financial aid eligibility for 2007-2008 and Summer Session II aid is based on financial aid eligibility for the upcoming academic year, 2008-2009. For this reason, Summer Session II aid awards CANNOT be processed until your 2008-2009 renewal aid application file is complete.

#### **Budget Determination**

The budget for summer sessions is based on the number and type of classes you take, the health fee, and average estimated costs for housing, meals, books, and personal expenses. A student's eligibility is determined by subtracting from this budget 25% of the academic year's Parent Contribution.

#### **Deadlines**

For Summer Session I, your aid application must be submitted by **May 9<sup>th</sup>**. For Summer Session II, your aid application must be submitted by **June 21<sup>st</sup>**. Funds are limited and may not be available to students applying after these dates; however please do not turn in applications until you are certain in which courses you will be enrolling.

#### **Summer Earnings Requirement**

Students engaged in particular activities during the summer may be eligible to have their Expected Student Contribution for the 2008-2009 academic year replaced with grant funds. Such activities include:

- attendance in summer school
- participation in a summer Duke Engage program
- some internships directly related to a student's course of study.

*It is important to note that federal aid eligibility standards will in some cases, prevent such grant replacement. Please contact your counselor if you have questions.*

Students are eligible to receive this grant replacement of their Expected Student Contribution from summer earnings for no more than two terms (1 full summer) during their Duke experience. However, the grant replacement does not need to occur in two consecutive terms. For example, a student can use half of his/her grant replacement in one summer, and half in another.

## Financial Aid Budgets

 $\frac{1}{4}$  of the academic year parent contribution.

**Example:**

A student takes 1 non-lab course and 1 lab course during Summer Session I. The total budget used to determine this student's financial aid eligibility is \$7,988. This figure includes \$5,500 tuition, \$280 books, \$915 room, \$815 board, \$389 personal expenses, and \$89 health fee. The parent contribution for 2007-2008 was \$10,000. Therefore, we take the budget of \$7,988 and subtract  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the parent contribution, \$2,500. The remaining amount, \$5,488, is covered with need-based financial aid consisting of Work-Study, loan, and grant. Alternative loans are available through the Loan Office to cover the parent contribution during summer terms.
